HASH hISTORY



Alberto Esteban Ignacio Gispert, hash name "G" Along with "Torch" Bennett, Cecil Lee and a few others, "G" founded the Hash House Harriers at the Selangor Club in late 1938, the name being taken from the local nickname for the Selangor Club.

- 1967 (August) Sydney HHH formed Australia's first HHH
- 1967 (August) Hobart HHH formed Australia's second HHH
- 1971 first HHH in United States, the Fort Eustis HHH
- 1973 1500th KL HHH run (by which time there were 35 other HHH clubs
- 1980- Trinity HHH formed there were about 120 other HHH clubs in 36 countries
